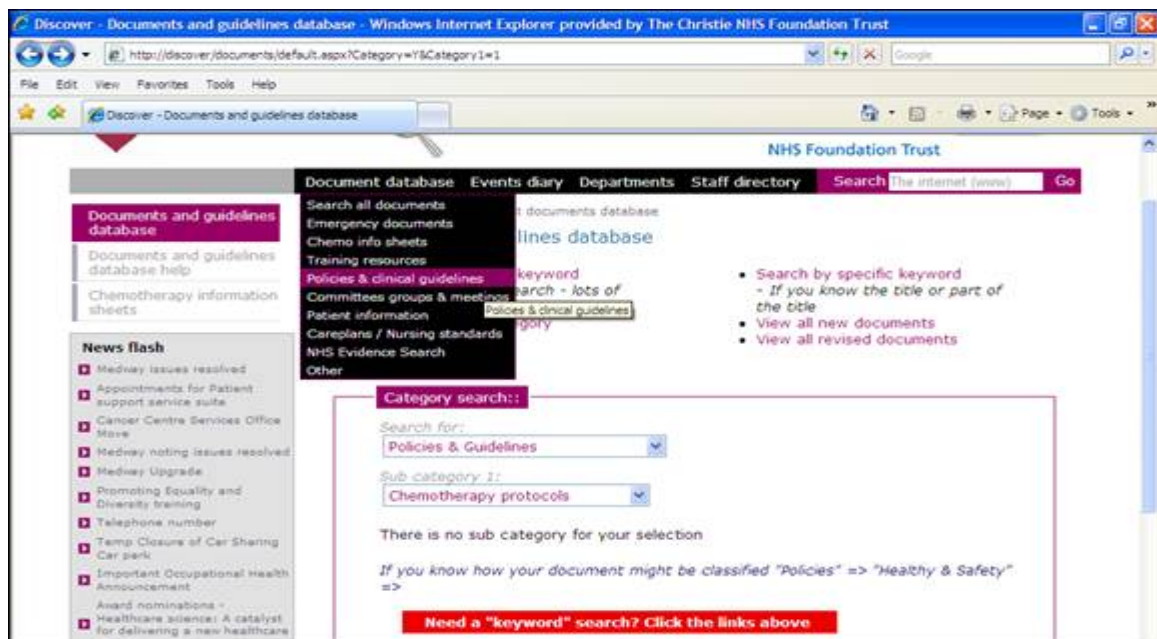


Colorectal CSG Chemotherapy Treatment Algorithms Measure No: 11-1C-124d
